## Coat of Arms

## Historiography

The Barnhart Coat of Arms illustrated left was drawn by an herald artist from information officially recorded in ancient heraldic archives. Documentation for the Barnhart Coat of Arms design can be found in Siebmacher's Wappenbuch. Heraldic artists of old developed their own unique language to describe an individual Coat of Arms. In their language, the Arms (shield) is as follows:

"On a red background is a black bear, rearing up on its hind legs. Above and to the right is a gold star."

Above the shield and helmet is the Crest which is described as:

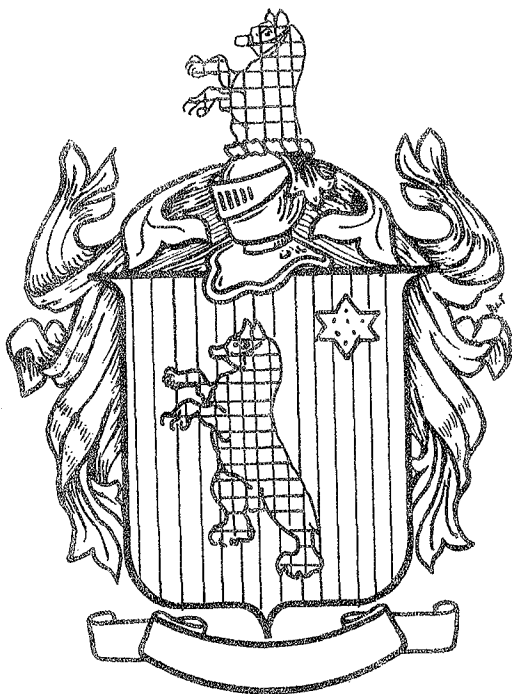
"A black bear growing out of the helmet."

When translated the blazon also describes the original colors of the Barnhart Arms and Crest as it appeared centuries ago.

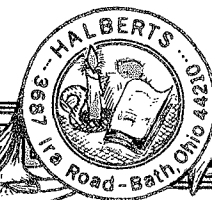
Family mottos are believed to have originated as battle cries in medieval times. A Motto was not recorded with this Barnhart Coat of Arms.

Individual surnames originated for the purpose of more specific identification. The four primary sources for second names were: occupation, location, father's name, or personal characteristics. The surname Barnhart appears to be characteristic in origin, and is believed to be associated with the English, meaning, "an Anglicised version of the German Berinhard, which means, "strong and hard like a bear." The supplementary sheet included with this report is designed to give you more information to further your understanding of the origin of names. Different spellings of the same original surname are a common occurrence. Dictionaries of surnames indicate probable spelling variations of Barnhart to be Bernhard, Bernhardi, and Berinhard. Although bearers of the old and distinguished Barnhart name comprise a small fraction of the population there are a number who have established for it a significant place in history.

They include: BARNHART TREVISIALUS (1406-1490) Italian alchemist. His chief work was that of all alchemists, the search for a device that would transmute base metals into gold. He wrote several books, most of them concerning this search. After 60 years of effort, in 1481, he claimed to have succeeded in making the Philosophic's Stove in its purist form. JOHANN JAKOB BARNHART (Bernhardi) (1774-1850) German botanist who was born in Efurt. He was Director of the Efurt Botanical Gardens. He revised the Linnean system of plant classification. He wrote several books, one of which deals with his classification system, and the others of which concern his studies of reeds and ferns. HENRY A. BARNHART (1858-1934) American Congressman who was born near Twelve Mile, Indiana. He was educated at the Omboy Academy and Wabash Normal Training School. A schoolteacher by trade, he was made Fulton County Surveyor from 1885 to 1887. He was Editor and Publisher of the "Rochester Sentinel", for 35 years, and the President of the Rochester Telephone Company from 1886 on. He was President of the National Telephone Association and Director of the Northern Indiana Prison. He was elected to Congress for five terms from 1908 to 1919. ## Historiography

The Barnhart Coat of Arms illustrated left was drawn by an heraldic artist from information officially recorded in ancient heraldic archives. Documentation for the Barnhart Coat of Arms design can be found in SIBBMACHER'S WAPPENBUCH. Heraldic artists of old developed their own unique language to describe an individual Coat of Arms. In their language, the Arms (shield) is as follows:

“SCHRAGGESTELLTE LANZENSPITZE.”

When translated the Arms description is:

“A LANCE BLADE, PLACED DIAGONALLY.”

Individual surnames originated for the purpose of more specific identification. The four primary sources for second names were: occupation, locational, patronymical (father's name) and personal characteristics. The surname Barnhart appears to be patronymical in origin and is believed to be associated with the Germans meaning, “descendant of Berinhard, (bear, strong).” The supplementary sheet included with this report is designed to give you more information to further your understanding of the origin of names. Different spellings of the same original surname are a common occurrence. Dictionaries of surnames indicate probable spelling variations. The most prominent variations of Barnhart are Barnhardt and Barnhard.

Census records available disclose the fact there are approximately 9,656 heads of households in the United States with the old and distinguished Barnhart name. The United States Census Bureau estimates there are approximately 2.2 persons per household in America today which yields an approximate total of 21,243 people in the United States carrying the Barnhart name. Although the figure seems relatively low, it does not signify the many important contributions that individual's bearing the Barnhart name have made to history.

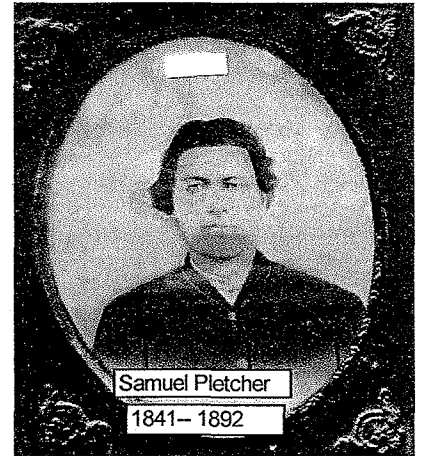

# 'Cooperative spirit' calls Burns, Maggi to pursue commissioners' office

Washington County Commissioner Bracken Burns and Sheriff Larry Maggi believe together they can correct the wrongs that have occurred in county government over the past four years.

"We plan to build on our solid track records and provide effective government to Washington County by moving forward with a cooperative spirit," Burns said Monday before a packed house at the American Legion Post 175 in Washington.

Hundreds of people had gathered in anticipation of Burns' and Maggi's noon announcement that they were teaming up to run for the two Democratic nominations for Washington County commissioner.

Former state Rep. Leo Trich was the moderator for the political production, which included a disc jockey playing patriotic tunes, the Mon Valley Leathernecks military color guard and free hot dogs.

Trich introduced Burns as "a true Democrat, a true leader and a true friend to all of us."

Burns, of South Strabane Township and a two-term commissioner, referred to his more than 30 years of public service in Washington County, including his stints as di-

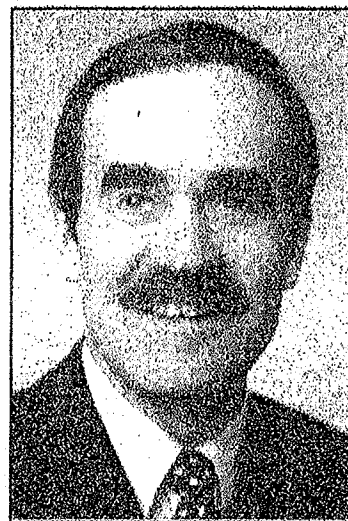

rector of the county's Emergency Management Services, chairman of Washington County Health Partners and chairman of Washington County Beautification Committee.

In 1995, Burns was elected to his first term as commissioner. Over the next four years, he said that he and his colleagues "were able to make a difference." He said there was the introduction of the FITS program, the Alzheimer's wing at the Washington County Health Center, the fight to preserve the old jail as an office building and the development of the Panhandle Trail.

Things changed in his second term, however, as Burns referred to a "betrayal of false friends" when he was not named board chairman. Instead, first-term Democratic Commissioner John Bevec was elected

chairman with Republican Commissioner Diana L. Irey named vice chairman.

"My efforts were compromised over the last three years," he said. "The county deserves commissioners that respect employees, colleagues, citizens and, of course, veterans."

After announcing his candidacy for re-election, Burns asked audience members to support Maggi as his running mate.

Fresh off of losing his bid for U.S. Congress last year, Maggi, of Buffalo Township, is serving his second term as county sheriff. Previously, he was a trooper and criminal investigator with the Pennsylvania State Police for 24 years.

"It will be a pleasure to work together with Bracken for the good of Washington County," Maggi said. "We will work together to bring sta-

bility to the commissioners' office."

He added, "Our visions are the same. Our political philosophy is the same."

Both candidates said they pride themselves on being veterans, and through their experiences, can best understand and fight for veterans throughout the county.

"I'm embarrassed by what the board of commissioners did to the veterans community," Burns said. "We will stand for veterans forever."

Tensions have been strained between the commissioners and the veterans for nearly a year, as they have not been able to agree on various veterans issues. Most recently, county veterans have been outraged over the firing of Col. Charles Rockwell as director of the Veterans Affairs Office.

meals to feed the workers. The designs also call for a concession stand and restrooms.

The corps, however, may have other priorities.

"I hope this talk of war isn't going to hurt us," Ludwin said.

Schafer presented the design earlier this month to Canon-McMillan School Board.

"He's trying to develop a nice park for the community," Schafer said about Ludwin. "I told him we don't have any money to contribute, we have land. If they get this off the ground, they have their sights set on Muse."

Ludwin said he would like to see multiple fields behind Muse Elementary School, including a ball field and recreation building constructed on a 26-acre tract.

The school board so far has taken no action on the matter. Ludwin said he'd like to attend a meeting in the future to answer any questions the board may have about the project.

"We're waiting for a final say-so from the school board and then we'll go to the township," Ludwin said.

Ludwin, a board member of Montour Trail Association, also envisions a mile-long branch from the trail connecting to Muse.

Richard Crown, Cecil Township manager, said the possibility of constructing a football or soccer field at Cecil Middle School has been discussed for the past five or six years.

The township has been developing other playing fields and hopes to complete a ballfield at Lawrence Park so it can be used this year, possibly before spring.

"The winter weather has been hard on us," Crown said.

Tragedy struck the Crow family early Sunday morning May 1, 1791. The four Crow sisters Elizabeth 19, Susan 16, Katherine 14, and Christena 11 had gone to visit an elderly couple Thomas & Mary Lazear who lived on a hill not far from Crabapple Run.

The girls walked along the bank of Crow Creek enjoying the beautiful spring day, until they reached a point near the mouth of Wharton's Run, about one mile up stream from their homestead. It was here the girls met Michael Crow their elder brother who had gone to the house of David Braddock to retrieve a horse and was returning home. Upon reaching the girls he warned them of lurking danger and that Indians might be prowling in the area. He asked the youngest girl Christena to go home with him, but she declined. He then proceeded on down the creek toward home, he noticed that his horse snorted and pranced uneasy. Neither Michael nor his four sisters knew that Indians were hiding behind a large rock that extended out of the creek bank, not twenty feet from the water. The Indians could easily have shot Michael a few moments earlier as he rode by.

Waiting until Michael got out of sight, two Indians and a white renegade called Spicer, jumped from behind the rock and seized the girls, ordering them upon the threat of death to be quiet. They then led the girls to a flat a short distance upon the hill behind the rock, sitting them on a log. The girls began speaking in German a language the Indians could not understand, were ordered to stop. One Indian departed in the direction in which Michael had gone. Susan was led a short distance around the hill and was raped. Spicer the white renegade, plied the girls with questions about the nearest settlements in the area. Upon the return of the other Indian a council was held. One Indian was in favor of carrying the girls into permanent captivity, while the other was in favor of slaying the girls immediately. The arms of mercy was powerless... The bloodthirsty Indians ruled that the girls should be killed.

Christena an eye witness to the tragedy and almost a victim herself. One Indian held two of the girls, by placing their palms together he held them firmly with his left hand. The other two held one girl each. Susan was the first to die, she dodged the tomahawk blow but the tomahawk cut deep into her jugular vein; the blood gashed out at yards length. The Indian that held her jumped back to avoid the blood. Elizabeth fought desperately and almost got loose, the tomahawk of Spicer knocked her to the ground. Christena the youngest girl being held with Katherine gave a sudden jerk, the Indian that held them could not hold them both, Christena got loose and fled. Another Indian gave pursuit grazing her in the back with his tomahawk, continuing her escape Christena threw herself over a cliff into a deep ravine. The Indian thinking she was dead returned. Christena hastily made her way toward home avoiding their often used path to elude the Indians. Reaching home in a breathless and terrorized manner, she gave the tragic news! Fearing an all out Indian attack, Jacob Crow took his family and immediately started out for Fort Lindley, young Michael Crow carried his little three year old sister Mary the entire distance upon his shoulders. Reaching Fort Lindley a posse of scouts were formed to overtake the savages.

Elizabeth the eldest girl, although being severely scalped somehow survived, she made her way crawling to the creek for water. A hunter by the name of Enlow happened upon the scene, it was here he found Elizabeth lying by the creek yet still alive. He carried her to a large rock back in the field making her as comfortable as possible, he then immediately secured for help. Meeting Michael Crow and the scouts from Fort Lindley, he quickly returned. Elizabeth's scalp was found tangled in a thorn bush not far from the area. A doctor was summonsed from Washington PA. to sew the scalp back on. Elizabeth was returned to her home.

Susan and Katherine was placed in a single grave in the family cemetery near their home. The doctor continued to work over Elizabeth. The severe wound, the exposure to the sun and element, was too much. Tuesday morning May 3, 1791 Elizabeth died. She too was laid to rest beside her sisters in the family burial plot.

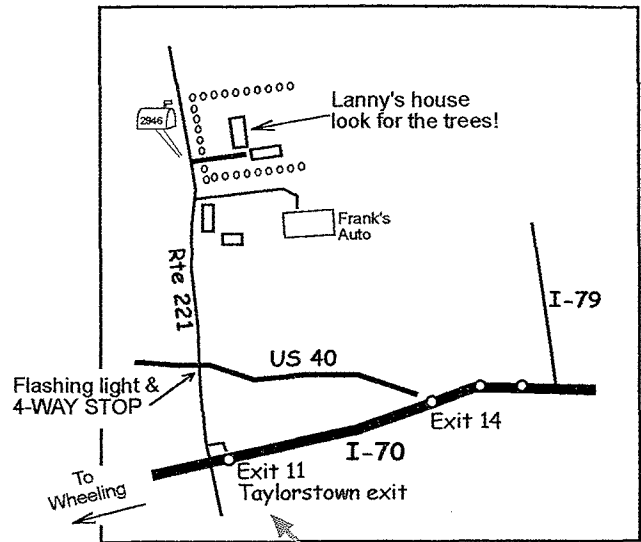
