## CEMETERIES OF BUFFALO TOWNSHIP

Cemeteries provide an important and inescapable link to our past. More often than not, the grave stones are the only proof that their lives ever existed. Consequently, they are an invaluable source of information to present and future generations. Unfortunately, many graves were never marked with a stone, or the stones in many cases, have become unreadable. Records, if they ever did exist, have since been lost. The only exception being that of South Buffalo, where a copied list did exist and a partial list of East Buffalo. Thus began the task of copying each one, grave by grave, brushing and chalking those stones that were weather worn to bring out their bits and pieces of information.

There are eight known cemeteries or burial grounds in Buffalo Township. Of these five are church cemeteries and the remaining three are private. Only one, North Buffalo, is still used for interment. Whether it was the unpredictable condition of the early roads, the lack of better transportation, the desire of earlier Americans to have their loved ones buried on their own land, or perhaps a combination of all three, the private or family cemetery was not uncommon.

With a few exceptions, only those graves that pre-date 1900 were copied, for a more efficient and systematic method of record keeping was used around the turn of the twentieth century.

Accuracy was of paramount importance in copying the graves and where a doubt existed as to a name or date a (?) was inserted.

In this, our Bicentennial year, all effort was made to determine those who had fought in the revolution and are designated as such.

With the knowledge that as the years pass, time will make more and more of the gravestones illegible, we record their names in this book with the hope that perhaps we have added a measure of permanence to their names and to the fact that they too at one time lived.

The following names are those, who, according to Veterans Administration records, fought in the American Revolution and are known to be burried in Buffalo Township.

As stated in "The History of East Buffalo Church," (1911), the East Buffalo Cemetery is located on land deeded "to the German Societies of this neighborhood being of the presbyterians (?) and church persuasion for school, meeting house and burial ground forever," by Hardman Horn and Elizabeth his wife, Lawrence Streker and Barbara his wife, and Michael Ely and Mary his wife, in the year 1802. It was used as a burial ground as early as 1796. It is located 1 mile south of Rt. 40 and adjacent to the East Buffalo Presbyterian Church.

# **Old Buffalo Burying Ground**

**Established 1795**

## "OLD BUFFALO BURYING GROUND ESTABLISHED IN 1795"

The old Buffalo burying ground located about two miles southwest of Independence, just over the state line in West Virginia, was established in 1795.

It is one of the oldest cemeteries in the area and is kept in good condition. The date 1795 is carved on the stone steps at the entrance.

This burying ground was laid out by the Lower Buffalo Presbyterian Church, now located in the village of Independence. There are no available records of the first Lower Buffalo Church erected near this old cemetery, which at that time was in the state of Virginia. The first church was of logs from the virgin forests surrounding the church.

The first mention of the church was in the records of Redstone Presbytery which met at Chartiers May 29, 1789, when James Hughes declared his acceptance of a call to Lower Buffalo and Short Creek. He served from April 1790 to June 1814. Supply pastors served from 1814 to 1819 when Jacob Cozad accepted a call. Evidently the burying ground was laid out during the pastorate of James Hughes.

Records filed in the courthouse at Wheeling show that Charles Wells and Elizabeth Wells sold to the congregation of Buffalo on November 2, 1795, two and one half acres of ground to Rev. James Hughes, William Beard, Henry Hervey, William Cruithers, William Buchanan and John Moore, the pastor, elders and trustees of the church. The price for the 2 1/2 acres and eight perches was three pounds. There are no records showing the location of the church.

The second church was erected on the ridge a short distance north of the first church, on what was recently known as the W.B.Gist farm. Wheeling records show Charles Wells and Margaret of Washington County sold to Thomas Grimes, John Adams, George A. Vincent and Thomas Patterson, trustees of Lower Buffalo Presbyterian Church September 8, 1821, fifty perches of land for \$1.00.

This church was erected of stone in 1822, and served as the home of the congregation until 1850, when the third church home was erected in the village of Independence. It was of frame structure. This building was destroyed by fire January 1, 1917.

The present building is of brick and was dedicated in December 1918. The records show this land where the present church stands was sold by Richard Carter, the first postmaster of the village, to Lower Buffalo Presbyterian Church trustees David Waugh and Thomas George June 1, 1850 for \$75. The ground contained three rods (rods) and 29 perches. The church has served the community for over 180 years.

The old burying ground is the resting place for many of the members of this early congregation and the community. It is enclosed with a huge stone fence, many of the stones being three feet or more in length and 15 to 18 inches square. In 1944 a cyclone lifted many of these stones and carried them several yards and many of the old time monuments were toppled over.

Miss Margaret Parkinson left a trust fund to keep the old cemetery mowed and kept in first-class condition. All the stones were replaced on the fence and the monuments reset.

Harlan Keenan, a native of the Independence section but now of Washington and interested in local history, has made a complete record of all the inscriptions on the monuments. He also got the information from the records in the Wheeling court house as to the early purchase of the ground on which the churches were erected. No doubt there are many burials there in unmarked graves.

The following list of burials and inscriptions, which should be of interest may not be complete as the writer knows of some burials not recorded in this list. \*\*\*\* SAMUEL BUCHANAN Born: 1840 Died: April 14, 1864 aged 24 years. Due to his name and age and place of burial near Thomas and Sarah Buchanan, as well as beside the Smileys, ~~xxxx~~ and Mc Cunes, this is likely Samuel Mc Cune Buchanan, known by the pen name of "HACKBETACK" who lived in Taylorstown. Have several letters of his to E. Mc Bride in Allegheny. Letters go up to about time of his death and then no further sign of him. Don't know what the relationship is to the Mc Cunes but must have been a Buchanan girl married to a Mc Cune or maybe a Smiley girl from his mothers family.

\*\*\*\* Thomas Buchanan Born: 1803 Died: July 20th 1869. Son of John Buchanan and Miss Foster (wife) who lived in Chartiers Township. He was a farmer, raised in Chartiers Township, spent his early married life farming in Peters Twp. then moved to Buffalo Twp on a farm and then moved to Cross Creek Twp.

\*\*\*\*Thomas Buchanan..cont. He had four sons (1) James Smiley Buchanan (2) John Force Buchanan (3) Alexander Buchanan (4) Samuel ~~Smiley~~. Since the Samuel is listed without a middle name and we know he was really Samuel Mc Cune Buchanan, he is likely the Samuel buried beside his parents.

\*\*\*\*SARAH (SMILEY) BUCHANAN Born: June 16, 1798 Died: June 18, 1875 aged 77 yrs 2 She was a daughter of James Smiley of Cross Creek, who is buried in the same cemetery near her.

\*\*\*\*John Buchanan and his wife, the former Miss Foster, are also buried in North Buffalo Cemetery but their graves are not marked. There are two grave sites without markers at the end of the row in the Buchanan burials and I assume they are buried there without stones having been erected. The cemetery records should show whether this is so.

Note: The records of the early burials were written by the keeper of the cemetery, and his spelling was neither very good nor accurate. His records were kept more from hearsay than by copying from any official document. The first two burials I have recorded are prime examples. Buchanan is spelled Buccannan in both cases--though the names are spelled correctly on the tombstones. In the one case, the cause of death is listed as PROLASES, what ever that is, and in the case of the husband, it is listed as General debility, when, in truth, both Alexander and his wife died of TYPHOID FEVER which they contracted, likely from their home water well.

\*\*\*\*All the first group of burials are in one large family plot, marked off by a large stone with the name BUCHANAN on it, and facing a wrought iron settee for family members to sit on when contemplating the plot. This plot is one of the first one meets when entering the cemetery from the road...it being on the right side of the cemetery road and quite prominent. The major part of the Buchanans in this cemetery are in this plot.

\*\*\*\*The second Buchanan plot in this cemetery lies just at where the cemetery road divides to go round about the hillside. If you approach this intersection from the state road, this plot lies immediately to the left of the cemetery road. If you should follow the cemetery road around the hillside, this plot lies just to the right of west of where the road rejoins the main cemetery road. This plot evidently is of some Catholic members of the family, judging from the stone and its inscription.

\*\*\*\*\*The grave of Colin Buchanan has a GAR flag holder on it indicating that he was a Civil War Veteran.

\*\*\*\* In this same plot is a solitary stone with the number "298" on it. It appears that this stone does mark a burial, but whoes? It possibly could be a boundary marker for the plot, but, if so, there are no others in sight. This is somewhat of a mystery that may clear up in time.

Joseph Henderson (1763-1837) married Mary/Polly Buchanan (1784-1865). She was a daughter of William Buchanan and Mary\_\_\_\_\_. Her Father, William, was born in 1738 in Ireland and died in January 1, 1814 and is buried at Lower Buffalo Cemetery with his wife. She had brothers and sisters by the names of John Buchanan (1771-1855) married Isabella Wilson (1783-1863); Alexander Buchanan (1776-1843) married \_\_\_\_\_ McElhane then Martha Craig; Elizabeth Buchanan (1777-1829) married Samuel Gilmore (1770-1814); Margaret Buchanan (1781-1845) married George Blayney. Joseph Henderson and his wife Mary/Polly had children named Thomas Henderson, John Henderson, Joseph Henderson, Samuel Henderson, Mary Jane Henderson (grave above), Elizabeth Henderson and Rebecca Henderson.

The Jacob Richardson family settled in Taylorstown where they were hat makers and cloth makers. Our ancestor, Alexander Buchanan, married Alice Maria Richardson, daughter of Jacob Richardson, who was likely this man. A son, Jacob Richardson, was a noted Civil War officer. The son is buried at North Buffalo Cemetery. It is sad to note that Jacob died at such an early age and that his son died within less than a month of him--likely pneumonia or some such winter ailment for which there was no treatment in those days.

\*\*\*\* REBECCA BUCHANAN Born: 1783 Died: March 10, 1852 aged 69 years. She was the widow of Alexander Buchanan of Hopewell Township, Washington County, who died in 1843 and a copy of whoes settlement of estate I have. No location or dates on Alexander Buchanan, but they should be on Record in the Washington County Court House. The settlement mentions a Jane Buchans as a legatee, who was evidently a daughter.

\*\*\*\* William Vasbinder Born: 1772 Died: February 28, 1835 aged 63 years. He was from Carlisle, Pa.

\*\*\*\* Mary (Buchanan) Vasbinder Born: 1783 Died: July 1, 1842 aged 59 years. She was the daughter of John Buchanan and Mary Ross Buchanan.

\*\*\*\* Alex. Buchanan is buried in Old Buffalo Burying Ground. Died August 18, 1843, aged 67 years and 6 months. (Born: February 1776). This is evidently the husband of Rebecca as the first entries in his estate settlement are on August 22, 1843, or 4 days after his death.

The original individual markers have been replaced with one monument on which has been inscribed the above names.

The original marker of Joseph Ritner read:

This is a private cemetery located about one mile east of the North Buffalo United Presbyterian Church. The farm on which it is located originally belonged to Jacob Alter, but since 1835 has been in the Stewart Family. It is presently owned by William B. Stewart of Buffalo Township.

THE OLD CONTINENTAL CEMETERY

A degree of mystery surrounds this old burial ground, as very little could be found as to its origin. Brief reference is made to it in, "The History of East Buffalo Church." According to the "History," a frame building for a church was erected and afterward used for a school. According to one source a small village called "Wolf Village" once flourished nearby, pre-dating the Revolution. There are no readable gravestones but some of the graves are yet visible. It is located one half mile East of Rt. 221 on the dividing ridge between Buffalo and South Franklin Township. Originally owned by Jacob Wolf, the farm now belongs to Robert Burg of Buffalo Township.

Dr. Buchanan had already been here & given you this info. But you may or not  
know...the sexton has in his office a file with a card on every burial in the  
cemetery. He is extremely busy, but MAY send at your request, copies of all the  
Buchanan cards. (He sent me the Whitemans.) What he sends you still may not  
be ALL of them in the cem...the cards are in alphabetical order only according  
to who owns the lots. If a Buchanan is buried in a lot owned by someone of a  
different surname, you won't get the card...get it? Also, there are records in  
his file and old books from 1897 forward. The Citizens library at Wash. has a  
complete 2-volume xerox copy of the earliest cem. records from Claysville, from  
1879 forward, and it's completely indexed. Write the library, 58 S. College,  
Wash., PA 15301, refer to Miss Susan Priest, Ref. Librarian and ask for every-  
thing from this cem. on Buchanan and she'll send copies with bill...a minimum  
of \$2.50 for first 5 copies & 25¢ for each one thereafter. They have several  
volumes of other misc. Wash. co., PA cemeteries, all indexed.
