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FOREWORD

To preserve the records supplied by old gravestones in southern Beaver County, Pennsylvania, we have photographed the stones. Herein we present the inscriptions from graveyards at King's Creek, Tomlinson Run, Frankfort Springs United Presbyterian, Reddick Farm as well as the Civil War Monument in Frankfort Springs.

Frankfort Springs United Presbyterian Church was formerly called King's Creek, hence old King's Creek Graveyard. When the congregation moved to the edge of the borough, a new graveyard was established next to the church building. The old graveyard continued to be used, chiefly by members of the second King's Creek Church.

Tomlinson Run was organized in June 1834 by members of old King's Creek who lived in the northern reaches of the congregation, according to a history written by A.M. Nickle in 1884. The move to a more southern location of the old church occasioned the formation of the new church. Tomlinson Run Church is located on the southern edge of Green Township, the property having been acquired by the Church of Christ. The other graveyards herein treated are all in Hanover Township.

The second King's Creek Church was organized in 1854 about three miles west of Frankfort Springs. No graveyard was established there. The Session minutes of this church were abstracted by Anna W. Crouse and A.D. Dungan about twenty years ago, and are here presented in a rearranged form for easy reference.

Burial in a particular graveyard does not necessarily imply membership in the adjoining church. For example, Johnston Calhoon, ruling elder of Tomlinson Run is buried with other family members at Mill Creek. Zachariah Swearingen, a member of the second King's Creek is buried at Bethel.

The enumeration of the gravestones is by stone. The surname is not repeated for family members after the first member named. Other surnames are middle, maiden or previous names. In cases of persons with different surnames on the same stone, listings are by surnames with notations of the stones on which they appear. Abbreviations used are as follows: d/o, daughter of; s/o, son of; w/o, wife of. Material not on the stones is enclosed in parentheses. Since veteran markers have been moved or destroyed in some graveyards, we have not noted them.

SESSION MINUTES OF KING'S CREEK UNITED PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH ABSTRACTED
