In the Name of God, Amen.

I, Fredus Ryland, Senior, being in sound mind and tolerable health, and desirous while in this situation to dispose of my worldly property, do make and ordain this my last will and testament in the form and manner following, viz.

Item 1st - I give and bequeath to my daughter MARTHA, now MARTHA VANDERGRIFT, any cow she may choose from among my cattle, and no more.

Item 2nd - I give and bequeath to my daughter HARRIET the farm whereon I now live, together with ten acres of land on the head of Cattail Branch, being part of the lands which I purchased of Abm and Wm See's, to hold during her natural life, the above land to be solely managed and directed by PEARCE SAPPINGTON, who is hereby appointed and authorized to receive all rents and profits of the same and be her proper guardian. And in case the above named SAPPINGTON should die before the above named HARRIET, I hereby authorize my son FREDUS RYLAND to have full power to act in the same capacity that this SAPPINGTON did during his life.

Item 3rd - I will that the above mentioned land, after the death of my daughter HARRIET be divided into four equal parts viz: one fourth (part) to my son ALDRIDGE and his heirs forever, one fourth part to my son FREDUS and his heirs forever, one fourth to be equally divided among the children of ADKA PENNINGTON (note: daughter MARTHA's late husband) and their heirs forever, and one fourth to be equally divided among the children my daughter HESTER bore to PEARCE SAPPINGTON and their heirs forever.

Item 4th - I will that after all my lawful debts and funeral charges are paid, that the whole of my estate, real and personal (the above mentioned excepted) be divided in four parts, viz: one fourth part to my son ALDRIDGE and his heirs forever, one fourth part to my son FREDUS and his heirs forever, one fourth part to be equally divided among the children of ADKA PENNINGTON and their heirs forever, and one fourth to be equally divided among the children my daughter HESTER bore to PEARCE SAPPINGTON and their heirs forever, the parts of the minors to remain in the hands of my executor till they are of proper age to choose guardians for themselves, he paying interest thereon.

Lastly, I do hereby and authorize PEARCE SAPPINGTON to be the executor of this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all other wills by me made, either verbal or otherwise. In testimony of which I here unto set my hand this twentieth day of September AD one thousand eight hundred and two.

In testimony whereof, I have hereunto set my hand at New Castle, the second day of November AD one thousand eight hundred and three.

Be it remembered that on the second day of November AD 1803, the last will and testament of FREDUS RYLAND, late of New Castle County, deceased was in due form of law proved approved and insinuated and letters testamentary, thereon were granted unto THOMAS PEARCE SAPPINGTON (alias PEARCE SAPPINGTON) executor in the same will named, he being solemnly sworn well and truly to execute the said will and to exhibit an inventory into the registers office at New Castle on or before the second day of February next and to render a true and just account of his administration on or before the second day of November AD 1804. In the Name of God, Amen. I, Henry Ewing of Cecil County in the State of Maryland, being in a weak state of health in body, but of sound and disposing mind and memory and understanding, considering the certainty of death and the uncertainty of the time thereof, and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs and thereby be the better prepared to leave this world when it shall please God to call me home, do therefore and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form following: that is to say:

First and principally I commit my soul into the Hand of Almighty God, and my body to the earth, to be decently buried at the discretion of my executor herein after named, and after my debts and funeral charges are paid I devise and bequeath as follows:

Item, I give and devise unto my three sons, John, Moses and James my plantation on which I now dwell containing three hundred acres, more or less, to be divided among them agreeable to the lines run by David Mackey, Junior in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and eight, which lines I allow to stand.

Item, I give and devise to my son JOHN the north part or division of my land with one good feather bed and bedding, and two cows.

Item, I give and devise to my son JAMES the middle part of my land on which the mansion house stands, with remainder of my personal property hereinafter devised.

Item, I give and devise to my son MOSES the south part of my land on which the brick house stands, bounded by the above mentioned lines, with one good feather bed and bedding, and two cows.

My sons MOSES and JAMES to be at equal expenses in building a brick house on JOHN's land, with JOHN of the size of MOSES' house.

My son JAMES to convey his right, title and interest of seventy acres of land bought from Henry Ewing Cooper joining my land to my son JOHN. Otherwise, if he refuses to convey his right and title of said seventy acres of land, he is to pay my son JOHN eight hundred dollars after my decease.

My sons JOHN, MOSES, and JAMES to be equal shares in all money due me and them at this date, and to pay equal parts of all debts due by them and me at this date, and to pay equal parts of my daughters' legacies as they become due.

Item, I give and bequeath to my daughter SUSANAH GATCHEL two hundred dollars, to be paid in two years after my decease.

Item, I give and bequeath to my daughter NANCY SCOTT two hundred dollars, to be paid three years after my decease.

Item, I give and bequeath to my daughter POLLY two hundred dollars to be paid after my decease, with one horse worth eighty dollars and saddle, one good feather bed and bedding and bedseat, two cows, beureau and breakfast table, one set of china and half dozen silver teaspoons. My son JAMES to give my daughter POLLY's horse.

Item, I give and bequeath to my daughter BETSEY two hundred dollars to be paid five years after my decease with one horse worth eighty dollars and saddle, one good feather bed, bedseat and bedding, two cows, beureau, breakfast table, one set of china and half a dozen silver teaspoons.

Item, I give and bequeath to the heirs of my son ROBERT EWING, deceased, ten dollars to be equally divided among them.

Item, I give and bequeath to my son HENRY ten dollars.

I give to my son JAMES my personal property, except what is before bequeathed, which he is to give to each legatee when called for.

If any of my sons to whom my land is devised should die intestate without issue, the land to return to the surviving sons to whom the land is devised. My son MOSES is to give BETSEY her horse.

Item, I hereby constitute and appoint my son JOHN to be the executor of this, my last will and testament. In testimony whereof I have hereto set my hand and affixed my seal this twentyninth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and nine. Signed, sealed and delivered in the presence of Thomas Reynolds, Jacob Clement, Joseph Steel.
