Take Notice.

For general information, sections 49, 50, chapter 7 and 116 chapter 12 of the Book of Discipline are here given.

"If a communicant, not chargeable with immoral conduct, removes out of the bounds of his Church without asking for or receiving a regular certificate of dismissal to another Church, and his residence is known, the Session may within two years, advise him to apply for such certificate; and if he fails so to do, without giving sufficient reason, his name may be placed on the roll of suspended members, until he shall satisfy the Session of the propriety of his restoration. But, if the Session has no knowledge of him for the space of three years, it may erase his name from the roll of communicants, making record of its action and the reasons therefor. In either case, the member shall continue subject to the jurisdiction of the Session. A separate roll of all such names shall be kept, stating the relations of each to the Church. (49)

If any communicant, not chargeable with immoral conduct, neglects the ordinances of the Church for one year, and in circumstances such as the Session shall regard to be a serious injury to the cause of religion, he may after affectionate visitation by the Session, and admonition if need be, be

suspended from the communion of the Church until satisfactory evidence of the sincerity of his repentance, but he shall not be excommunicated without due process of discipline. (50)

If a church-member, more than two years absent from the place of his ordinary residence and Church connections, applies for a certificate of membership, his absence, and the knowledge of the Church respecting his demeanor for that time, or its want of information concerning it, shall be distinctly stated in the certificate." (116)

Discipline.

"Its object is to secure to the Church sound doctrine, godly living, encouragement to the well-doing and correction to the erring." Its exercise contributes to the glory and happiness of the Church.

Paul's advice, (Gal. 6:1) should ever be kept in mind "Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual restore such an one in the spirit of meekness." Uplift the tempted by leading them into pure society.

Practical Hints.
