Introduction

Two old cemeteries may be seen on the left as one follows the winding road leading from East Pittsburgh Street, Burgettstown to Cherry Valley Road that passes the present Raccoon Elementary School.

Beneath the sod of these two cemeteries lie the remains of early settlers in this region, many of whom were Scotch-Irish and embraced the religious principles of John Calvin and John Knox, European Protestant reformers of the 16th century who founded the Presbyterian domination. Likewise, later generations who attended the United Presbyterian or Presbyterian Churches of Burgettstown found their final resting places within the confines of these cemeteries.

The older of the two graveyards is situated farther east from Burgettstown near a double bend in the road and across from present Baloga property. The occupants of this cemetery were members of a "seceder" congregation known as the Associated Presbyterian Church established in the Burgettstown vicinity in 1800. The church in later years was called the First United Presbyterian Church of Burgettstown, and then in 1962 following the union with the former Westminister Presbyterian congregation, the Westminister Presbyterian Church.

The first building of the Associated Church in this area was a double log structure erected near the northeast corner of the aforementioned cemetery. It was replaced about 1845, by a frame structure built on the same site. About 1860, this frame building was moved in its entirety to the spot where the present Westminister Church of Burgettstown now stands. In 1873, it was moved again to the rear lot so excavating could be done for a new brick building, the present Westminister Presbyterian Church on South Main Street, Burgettstown.

No record has been found of the first burial in the "Old U.P. Cemetery" as this graveyard was generally called to designate it from the later one established by the Presbyterian Church; however, the oldest marker dates to November 18, 1808 and is that of James Smith.

The cemetery closer to Burgettstown Borough, just at the end of Vian and Pittsburgh Streets, was established by a Presbyterian congregation existing at Cross Roads (Florence).

A frame building was constructed in 1845, on the hillside southeast of Burgettstown (above the cemetery), and here the Presbyterians worshipped, apart from the Seceders or Associates. A charter, however was not granted by Synod to this group until 1849. Then the church became known as the First Presbyterian Church of Burgettstown. Many years later it was changed its name to Hillcrest Presbyterian Church.

As the congregation grew plans were made for a new brick edifice to be erected on Main Street just north of the newly constructed U.P. Church. It was finally built in 1874, and the old frame building above the cemetery was moved to the center of town on a site not far from the present intersection of Main Street and Route 18 by-pass across from Petrucci's Market. This frame building was then used as a town hall until destroyed by flood in 1912.

Meanwhile, the Presbyterian Cemetery on the hill continued to be used as a burial place for members of the congregation; however in 1895, when Fairview Cemetery was established just south of the Borough of Burgettstown, families of both the Presbyterian and United Presbyterian congregation often chose to intertheir loved ones in the new burial ground.


Intermittently for years efforts were made by the two churches to keep the original graveyards in good condition, but the old families sometimes died out or moved away. The plots were often neglected and funds were not available to keep up the cemeteries. Weeds grew rapidly in the springtime. Brushes and flowers once planted by devoted families ran wild. Headstones fell under the forces of wind and rain. Today the two cemeteries remain as pitiful reminders of those who once lived out their days in the valleys and along the hillsides of the Burgettstown community.

The first burial to take place in the Presbyterian Cemetery is said to have been that of Mrs. Catherine Lamb, but no date has been recorded of her death. And in 1976, an interment took place when the family of Hettie Leopold Kaiser chose to bury the body of their mother near her husband. Apparently no stone has yet been erected in her memory, but at this point in time she is the last person to have been buried in either of the two old graveyards.


Alvin D. White of Hickory, well known historian in northern Washington County and author of the revised edition of "The Cross Creek Graveyard and Cemetery" and "The Mount Pleasant Cemetery", as well as other regional histories, became aware some time ago of their slow deterioration of the two old cemeteries. He had frequently been sought out by persons interested in tracing their roots. Often these people wished to explore the graveyards for genealogical data, but their efforts were frustrated by the seasonal growth of vegetation which made the cemeteries almost impenetrable especially in the summer and fall when genealogist usually prefer to do their field work.

Mr. White has therefore assumed the task of listing what data is still available. He has used three means of gathering material. He consulted records from the Lee & Martin Funeral home in Burgettstown which performed most of the burials. He referred to a remarkable necrology kept for the time by the late William Melvin between the years 1881 and 1903 (this record is kept in the Historical Room of the Burgettstown Community Library). Finally, over a period of years, when the season permitted, he searched through the two cemeteries. In this effort he was encouraged by the Fort Vance Historical Society and assisted by a few friends: Charles Lawson, David Zollars, Kathy Dellanbaugh, and Katherine Pyle. Together with Mr. White they visited the graveyards, lifted some of the headstones which had fallen face downward to the earth and struggled to read the inscriptions which were sometimes impossible to decipher completely. Families are occasionally able to supply the missing data. If errors have occurred or names have been omitted this has been done inadvertently. The following pages stand as the best composite record available concerning those who lie in the old burial grounds.

The Whitaker Family Graveyard

This old family burial ground is located on the former Deacon Whitaker farm on a hill about one-half mile north of the Burgettstown Borough line.

It was a plot only about 50 feet x 50 feet in size and was at one time enclosed by a wire fence, with a few of the old posts still in place to mark the boundary.

The old yard was visited on May 11, 1970 by Edward Hamilton, of Burgettstown, and A. D. White, of Hickory.



Some eight or ten veterans of the Revolution lie buried in the Burgett Private Graveyard (but their names are not known).

Captain Samuel Fulton commanded a company at the Battle of Long Island.

The Burgett Graveyard

This old yard was a private burial ground located on the former Burgett land, and it is on the hill east of Our Lady of Lourdes Roman Catholic Church in South Burgettstown. This old yard was marked with a plague by the Fort Vance Historical Society on May 14, 1941, which was known as "Burgett Day" and on which occasion about fifteen members of the Burgett family were present, including Mr. and Mrs. Philip Burgett of Ft. Lauderdale, Florida. On this same occasion, plagues were placed at the old Burgett home and at the site of the Burgett Mill on Little Raccoon Creek nearby.

Almost nothing is known of the burials in this old yard, other than the reference, above, to the Revolutionary Soldiers, but it is believed that Sebastian Burgett, and his wife, Roxannah are buried here, and possibly his brother, George Burgett and his wife, together with younger members of the family, but few names are now known. Stones marking the graves there have been removed and there is little evidence of burials except the sunken condition of the ground at various points in the old yard.

One unproven story, a family member of Sebastian Burgett moved to Pittsburgh and had the headstones moved to a cemetery near their residence. Location is unknown.
