WASHINGTON COUNTY (PENNSYLVANIA) MARRIAGE BONDS 1803 - 1827

These bonds were found in the papers of the late E.B. Iams. They were apparently copied from court records about 1940. It is not known where the originals are. It is most unusual to find marriage bonds in this period in Pennsylvania.

The data are: Man, woman, date, bondsman.

MARRIAGE REGISTER OF SQUIRE THOMAS CARSON, JR.

Commissioned Justice of the Peace January 1, 1806 for Fallowfield Township, Washington County, Pennsylvania by Gov. Thos. McKean.

Squire Carson was a Baptist, and a member of the "Enan" Baptist Church, first situated at Spears, and later at the head of Maple Creek. (now, 1979 - no longer being used as a church.)

The original of this old marriage docket was in the possession of Walter Carson, Prothonotary of Washington County, January 1941. Mr. Carson was a direct descendant of Squire Thomas Carson. Material copied April 21, 1936 by E.B. Iams.
