Commenced practice of medicine in his native county, but four years ago removed to Ohio. About a year since he and his wife attached themselves to the Presbyterian Church -----

Leaves a large family. -- Was a member of the Cumberland Presbyterian Church. As husband and father was tender and loving, as a barrister, he had no superior in Western Pennsylvania. ----

She lived 50 years on the place where she died and 62 years with the husband she has left behind. This was during the Revolutionary War and by her account they had trying times in those days.

DEATH OF REV. CHARLES WHEELER

We noticed under the proper head last week the death of this venerable gentleman, but gave no particulars. He was about 68 years of age. The following extract from a letter dated Prunytown, Jan. 11, 1851, to the editor of the "Baptist Records", Morgantown, written by the Rev. Cleon Keyes, we find in the "Mirror":- I have sad news to communicate. Br. Wheeler is no more. He died this morning early. Although he has been for a long time in a critical state of health, none (or but a few perhaps) expected he would be gone so soon. He suffered intensely during his illness, but bore it all with Christian fortitude and resignation. He is now freed from sickness and pain and has doubtless entered into rest." Harrison (Clarksburg) Va. Republican.

The memory of Mr. Wheeler is fresh in the recollection of the people of this place. For many years he resided in the immediate vicinity of our Borough and was highly esteemed by the whole community.

The death of Mrs. Morris, relict of David Morris, formerly of this place, having been last fall reported to have taken place at New Lisbon, Ohio, but the fact of her decease not being generally known here, and no publication of it being made in any of our newspapers, I wrote to a friend of the deceased in New Lisbon and herewith send you an extract from his letter requesting that it may be published for the information of her numerous friends in Washington Co.

"The death of Mrs. Morris occurred Sept. 4 last. She had become quite frail and comparatively helpless. Her home had been with her niece, Mrs. Griswold, at Canton since leaving Penna. Early

last April, at her earnest solicitation, she was taken into the home of Mrs. Vallandigham of this place, whose acquaintance with Mrs. M. began while attending the boarding school of Mr. Baker, many years ago in Washington. She was surrounded by kind friends ----- but her heart yearned for friends of her earlier life and it was her desire to return to Washington and there pass the remainder of her days. But it was providentially otherwise directed. ---- Her mind was clear and active and towards her closing hours she gave directions that her death be communicated to certain friends she named. Her property - six or 8 hundred dollars by will is distributed among some relations in Carlisle and Pittsburgh."

From information derived from persons in this place, it is supposed that Mrs. Morris could not have been less than 80 years old. For most of her long life she was connected with the Secession Church. She was a woman of ardent and kind attachments and several shared liberally of her bounty while she lived in Washington. -----
